Centre Court development

The most recent project completed by Amillan was the cabling infrastructure for the Centre Court. 1,800 outlets of BrandRex Cat 6 cabling have already been distributed across the centre court and it has been designed to provide high speed, reliable connectivity in the media boxes to allow worldwide TV broadcasters to show live footage and commentary.

In addition to extensive new and refurbished hospitality areas and public eating facilities, a retractable roof is being built over the Centre Court in time for the 2009 championships. This will remove some of the unpredictability of the English summer weather and bring continuity to play during the tournament.

Museum building

The new Museum Building including the AELTC administration centre and train turnstiles was constructed and handed over on time in December 2006. Amillan provided the cabling infrastructure for the new building with 800 Cat 6 outlets being fitted throughout.

All projects at Wimbledon have a very tight timescale and the project management is critical to ensuring all work is carried out as planned so the facilities are 100% ready for the Championships each year. Amillan has always met the deadlines in place and co-ordinated with third parties where necessary to ensure the success of the cabling projects.
